

HOSPITAL CHAPEL DECOMMISSIONING

On Wednesday this week we held a decommissioning service for the use of the old chapel/whare karakia in the Grey Hospital. It was the second chapel at the hospital. The first was specially added to the original building as a result of a community fundraising effort that featured a radio-a-thon. When the hospital was altered in 1992, a new whare karakia was created. The original stained glass window was removed from the first chapel and installed in the new chapel.

At the conclusion of the formal decommissioning attended by about 6 clergy/pastors and 12 friends of the hospital and hospital staff, we decided what to do with the furniture.

The large heavy table will be placed at the back of the new chapel, together with a number of bibles available for anyone to use.

The stained glass window will eventually be removed from its present position in the wall of the 2nd chapel. It will then be hung in front of the new chapel window so that it will be displayed in all its beauty, and as a way of bringing inspiration, hope and comfort to those who use the facilities.

The priest's chair has been donated to St Patrick's Church to use behind their altar.

The organ and a table have been donated to The Shed.

THE END OF LIFE CHOICE ACT


